Andrew Yoder, our son, has taken Manelius' position as the Warehouse Manager. He has been with the company for 4 years has worked in the finish shop in a variety of positions during that time.

Henry Zook has been with us for 3 years and is responsible for drawing and building our custom orders . He is the one who will call you if there are any questions on your custom pieces. He owned a furniture shop in the past and has lots of experience with custom furniture.



This is a major project for us but a very positive move for the future of Superior Furniture.

My role as the owner is to stay focused on the big picture of the company. Delegating responsibilities to key people is essential to keep things running smoothly. We are very blessed with a good team of employees.

On a personal note, we live at the location where the finish shop and showroom is on 52 acres. We also own 94 acres, ¼ mile

As many of you already know, in February of 2015 Superior Furniture purchased the bookcase line and manufacturing from David Yoder at Wonder Wood. We leased the land and buildings from David on a 5-year lease. With the first option to buy the shop and land, the decision was made

not to purchase these but to relocate. In 2018 we purchased land a quarter of a mile from the finish shop. Plans are to start digging/excavating in May of 2020 and to build a 10,000 square foot manufacturing facility. This will more than double the size of the building we are currently working in. This will

allow us to bring more manufacturing in-house and allow us to serve our customers better. We hope to enhance our Quick Ship dining options. Stay tuned for more information in our next newsletter.
